Policy

The McMinnville Free Clinic is committed to providing free services to all patients without regard to race, color, national origin, disability, sex, sexual orientation, marital status, age, or spiritual affiliation. McMinnville Free Clinic and all staff members agree to comply with the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 1991, Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and Title VI as implemented by 45 CFR 80 and 84.

Procedure

The clinic shall provide services to all who need service, based on triaging guidelines, regardless of ability to pay. No patient shall be refused services or discriminated against in the course of providing services based on race, color, national origin, disability, sex, sexual orientation, marital status, age, or spiritual affiliation. However, McMinnville Free Clinic reserves the right to limit the number of patients seen and to refuse service to anyone.

The clinic will utilize the health center staff's language abilities and/or electronic devices to assist in translation as needed. McMinnville Free Clinic will, on occasion, utilize friends or family as translators for the non-English speaking patient with the patient's consent.
